## 3. Road repairs and Maintenance

- Roads are in pretty good repair at this time and the board has an agreement with the maintainer to monitor and fix the roads within the specified budget.
- Jack has an agreement with Mike Norton and the Wigwam Water technician to operate the backhoe during emergencies in Mike's absence. Jack's time is voluntary and he is not compensated for his time or services. The board appreciates any and all services that can be provided to the community to assist in keeping costs low and help with maintaining are area.

## 4. Public Comment

- Rumor of loss of water shares. This is just a rumor and our shares are still the same with 17% of each of the 2 wells.
- Landfills have started to be a problem and there are at least 3 that have been found in the past year. One of the property owners has a contact in the Pueblo County Health department and will submit that information to the board and assist us with getting the trash on these lots taken care of. The residents are encouraged to provide the board with any information on other landfills in our community. We need the lot number, owner, location, etc.
